


Establishes priority areas for longleaf restoration



*“Right acres in right place at right time”*

- Longleaf restoration at scale ~205,000 acres in 3 contiguous blocks
- Perpetual easement maintains working longleaf forest /longleaf system and is integral to completion of green corridor across Gulf Coast
- Strong nexus with DOA, DOI, DOD objectives – present and future
- Model for large scale working forest / landscape restoration
