



Over 1 billion people live in the streets or in poverty housing




Habitat for Humanity Canada

Founded

- 1976 Internationally and 1985 in Canada

Volunteers

- Over 50,000 in 73 locations in Canada
- Over a million in 2,300 locations worldwide

Homes

- More than 1,600 homes built in Canada
- More than 300,000 homes built worldwide

Current Building Rate

- 250 homes per year in Canada
- 25,000 homes per year internationally
(***One new home every 10 minutes***)


Brand



Our Green Building Strategy



- Administration, Building and Energy Standards
- To comply with EnerGuide 80, ≤ 1.5 ACH 50.
- ENERGY STAR appliances
- Water Management
 - ✓ Only low flow toilets
 - ✓ Low flow lavatories
- Healthy Housing Standards
- Low VOC finishes

- Minimum Environmental Standards
- Having a site appropriate waste management plan
- Use of Third Party Certified Forest Products ex: SFI, CSA, FSC
- Certifying homes to credible Green Building rating programs: ex Built Green, Novo Climate
- Limiting the framing waste order to 10%

“Best in Class” Green Building Programs

- 2008 – Approximately 10% of affiliates and 15% of all HFH homes
- 2009 - Approximately 25% of affiliates and 50% of all HFH homes
- 2010 – Approximately 50% of affiliates and close to 75% HFH Homes
- By 2013 HFH aims to have 100% of all homes certified annually.
