WOOD 4 GOOD PROGRAM

The Wood 4 Good program is an initiative between program participants of the Sustainable Forestry Initiative® (SFI) and Habitat for Humanity to work together for the benefit of future homeowners.

OBJECTIVE

To offer a simple and worthwhile solution for companies certified to SFI® Standards that want to liquidate excess building material product(s). Examples include discontinued inventory, shipment error, lightly damaged products, or other situations that require products to be liquidated.

BENEFIT

Habitat for Humanity has more than 1,400 local affiliates in the United States and more than 70 national organizations around the world. This ensures donated products are used locally in a way that builds sustainable communities.

WIN-WIN (ACKNOWLEDGEMENT LETTER FOR TAX PURPOSES)

For each donation made to Habitat by an SFI program participant, Habitat for Humanity International will provide to the participant a tax acknowledgment letter describing the donated product and date of donation. For donations directly to US Habitat affiliates, the affiliate will provide a tax acknowledgement letter to the SFI program participant.

SFI stands at the intersection of sustainable forests and sustainable communities. SFI is committed to promoting sustainable forest management in North America and responsible procurement of forest products globally.


