Comment

The Dalhousie mill has closed January 2008. Abitibi Consolidated and Bowater have merged to become AbitibiBowater. AbitibiBowater might choose to continue the production of this grade in another mill. Before closing Dalhousie has produced a lot of stock before closing hence this paper might be available from stock until July/August 2008.


